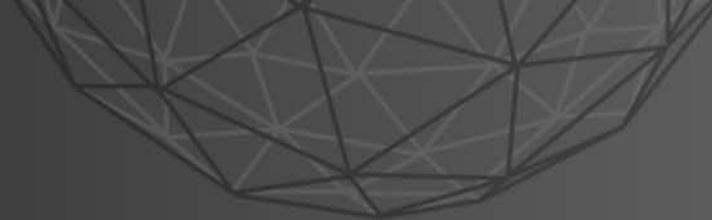


WHO WE ARE

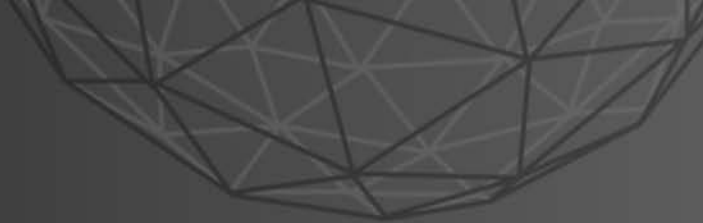

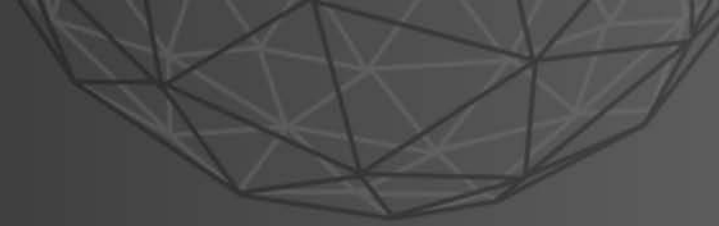




OUR GOAL

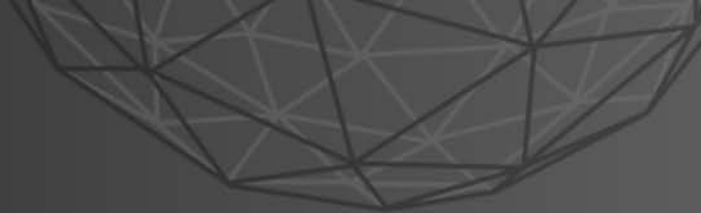




NEXT STEPS

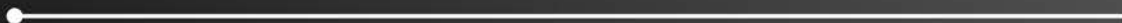
- 1** Develop property and establish operations on-site with nonprofit partners

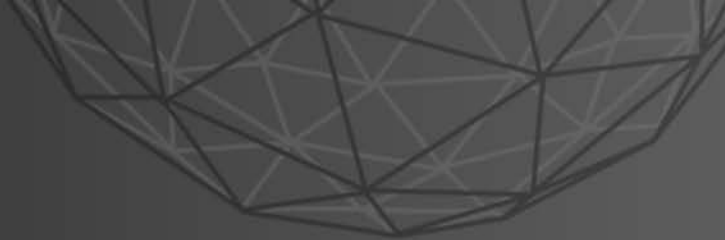




SUPPORT FOR NON-PROFITS AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

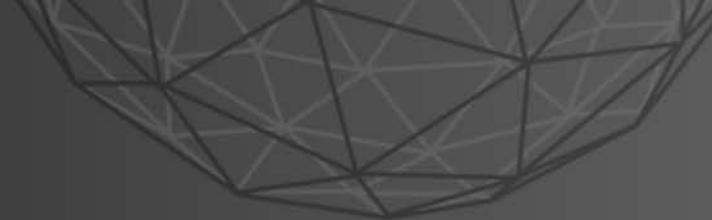

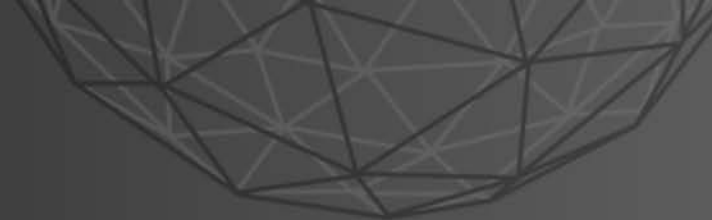


WHAT WE OFFER

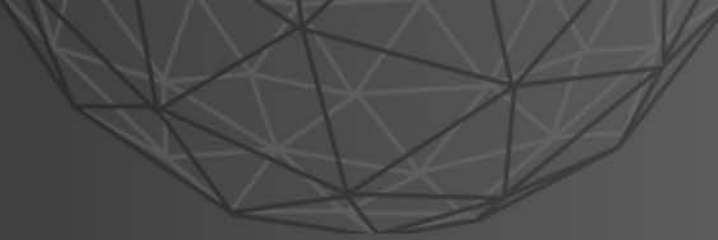

The MoonBass provided the property for the Donkey Kong Project, a state grant awarded to a non-profit partner to conduct an archaeological site survey aimed at engaging the public in learning about the property and archaeology.

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS, LLC

Community Connections, LLC is a women-owned archaeological consulting firm in Denver, Colorado, that specializes in connecting communities to their local heritage and history. They will connect our educational endeavors to the area's history and social issues. We provide services such as project design, public outreach, and education, as well as specialized services for unique projects that have specific goals outside of historical research, reports, and grant writing. Recent projects include partnering with Factor Earth to create augmented reality historical tours that make cultural resources accessible, working with communities such as Westminster Save the Farm and the Displaced Aurarians to facilitate their efforts in preserving valuable local heritage, and creating educational resources, like our artifact identifier, that promote cultural stewardship and responsibility.

STATE HISTORICAL FUND

The State Historical Fund awards grants funded by limited stakes gaming in the towns of Black Hawk, Central City, and Cripple Creek for significant buildings, structures, objects, districts, or archaeological sites, as well as for the preservation of historic resources in Colorado.

The MoonBass acquired a property and then partnered with several scientists, educators, and non-profits to apply for, win, and successfully execute a state grant through this fund, primarily through Community Connections, LLC.

Project Donkey Kong was an educational success, and many members of the community benefitted from the process and a public event co-hosted by the MoonBass, where the knowledge gained during the historical site survey was shared with community members, such as those from the Boys and Girls Club of Pueblo.

Our CEO supports this mission by directing individuals to its services and social media platforms and aims to play a larger role in the organization's development over the coming years. Its focus is to be a spiritual community for addicts, their loved ones, and spiritual refugees. We are discussing a partnership between this organization and Hook Ministries, Prayer for Prisoners, Houses for Warriors, and DG Cares' Return to Work initiative to manage our campus of rehabilitation domes that we have dedicated to the mission of each organization.

HOOK MINISTRIES

Post-COVID, the organization is focusing more on re-entry assistance and what is known as aftercare—caring for offenders who are now on parole or have recently been released. 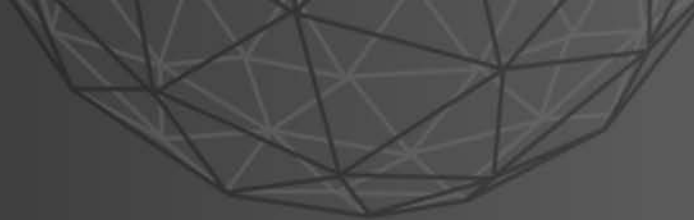

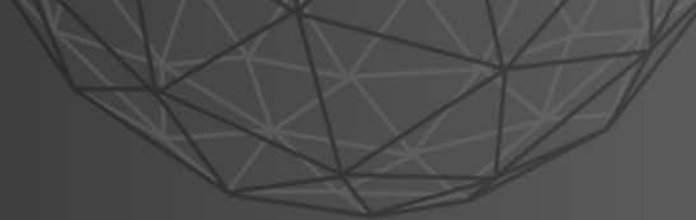

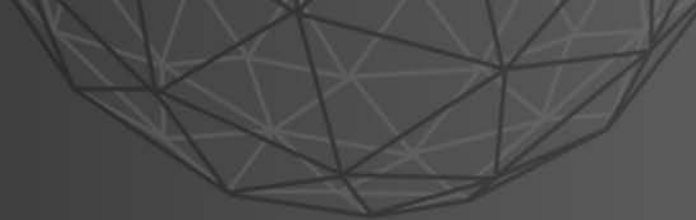
